### **Q 136. What are the sins forbidden in the sixth commandment?**

**A** The sins forbidden in the sixth commandment are, all taking away the life of ourselves,<sup>1</sup> or of others,<sup>2</sup> except in case of public justice,<sup>3</sup> lawful war,<sup>4</sup> or necessary defense;<sup>5</sup> the neglecting or withdrawing the lawful and necessary means of preservation of life;<sup>6</sup> sinful anger,<sup>7</sup> hatred,<sup>8</sup> envy,<sup>9</sup> desire of revenge;<sup>10</sup> all excessive passions,<sup>11</sup> distracting cares;<sup>12</sup> immoderate use of meat, drink,<sup>13</sup> labor,<sup>14</sup> and recreations;<sup>15</sup> provoking words,<sup>16</sup> oppression,<sup>17</sup> quarreling,<sup>18</sup> striking, wounding,<sup>19</sup> and whatsoever else tends to the destruction of the life of any.<sup>20</sup>
